Program Pricing

The price for a Residential Program is determined by the program length and whether a portion of the teaching is performed by school personnel. T-shirts are also available for an additional cost. Refer to the Residential Pricing Chart which outlines the pricing for 5-Day, 4-Day, 3-day and 2-Day Residential Programs. For a detailed explanation of the Residential Program, please see the “Residential Program Policies and Procedures” description sheet.

Program Length

Groups may request any program format. 3-day programs make up more than 60% of our residential programs and we will do our best to accommodate M-W & W-F programs. Other program lengths may be available depending upon demand during the month requested.

Teaching Module Length

Teaching Module or Trail Activity times may be approximately two hours or six hours in length. The 6-hour Module or “All Day Experience” is available to all schools. We encourage schools to participate in the “All Day Experience” because it provides students with better opportunities to explore their relationship with the environment, each other, and themselves.

School Personnel Teaching Option

For a Residential Program, school personnel have the option to teach a portion of the Trail Groups during Teaching Module time slots. Program price is dependent upon whether the school opts to have school personnel teach 25% of the total number of Modules during the program. Groups desiring Bradford Woods staff to cover 100% of all Teaching Modules (Trail Activities) will pay a higher rate.

Residential Program Price Includes...

The price of a Residential Program includes, but is not limited to, program leadership, cabin rental, meals, food service labor, and program materials and equipment. The Pricing Chart contains the pricing menu for Residential Programs taking place in Baxter, Lilly, and Griffith Villages during the academic year. All prices are per person including students and high school counselors. Two (2) teachers and/or adult chaperons per cabin (mandatory requirement) will receive a discounted price.
